INTERNATIONAL AND NATIONAL CONFERENCES

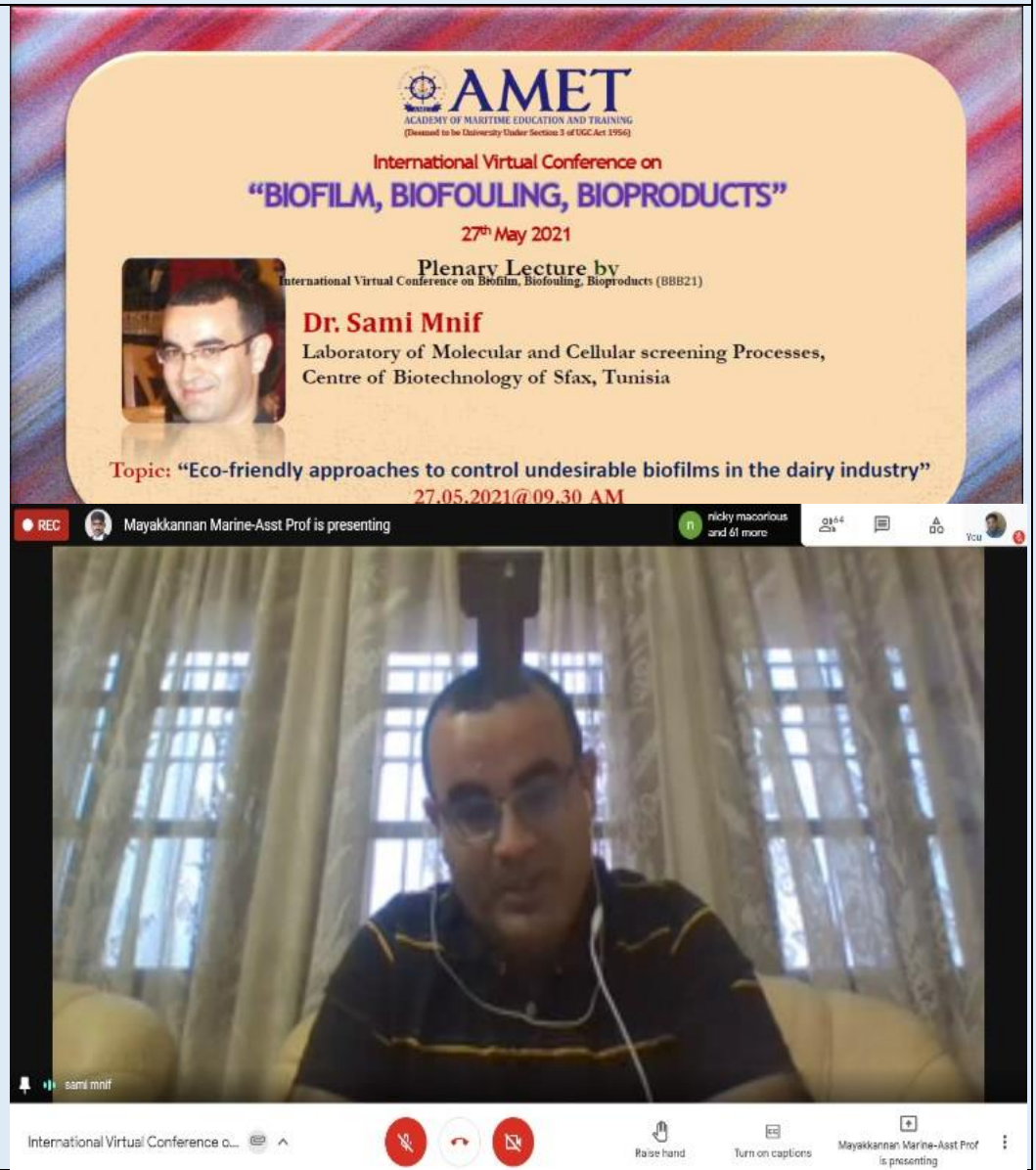
AMET Business School Organized National Conference on “Maritime India Vision – 2030” for two days from 28th and 29th June, 2020 - Virtual Event.



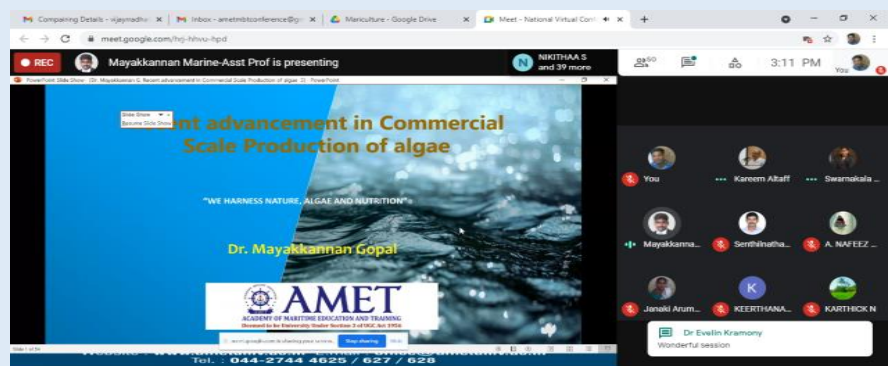
The Department of English conducted *National Virtual Conference on Contemporary Trends in ELT and Literature* on 23rd July 2021.

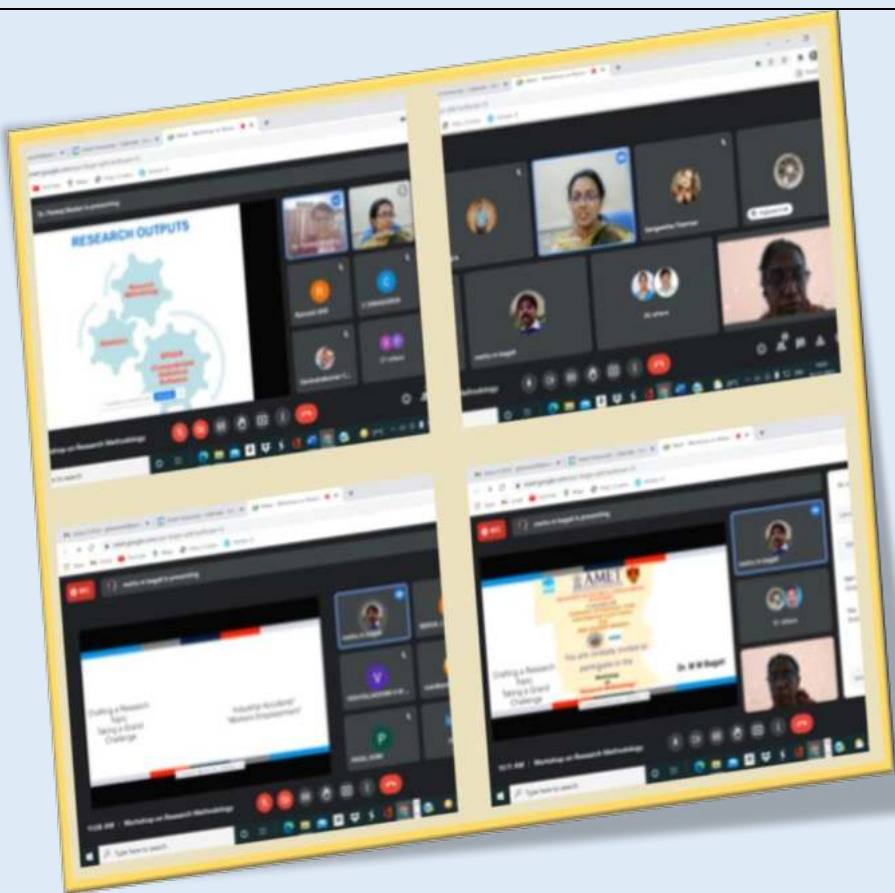

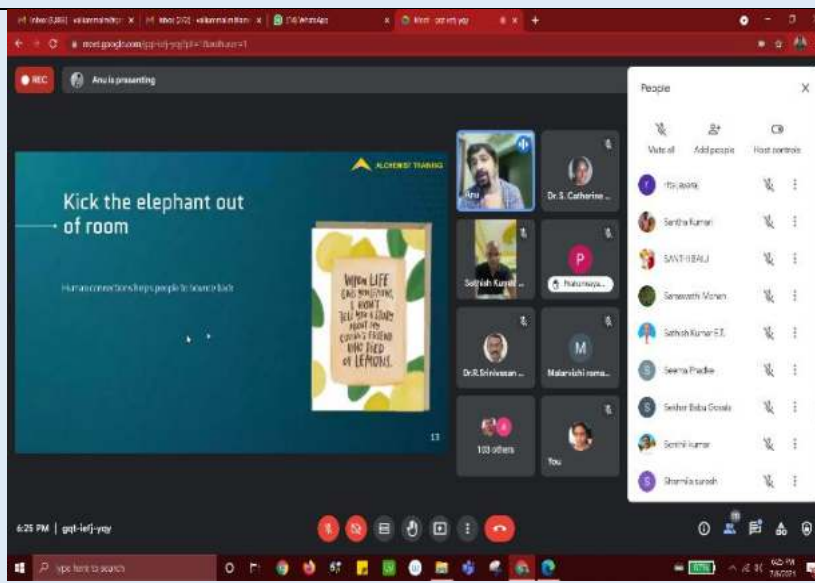

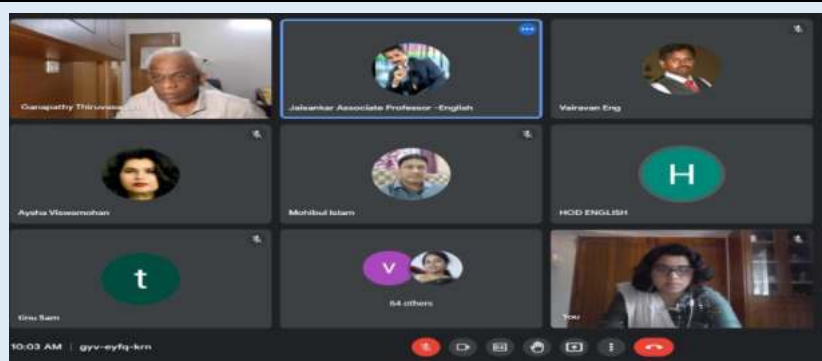


FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMMES

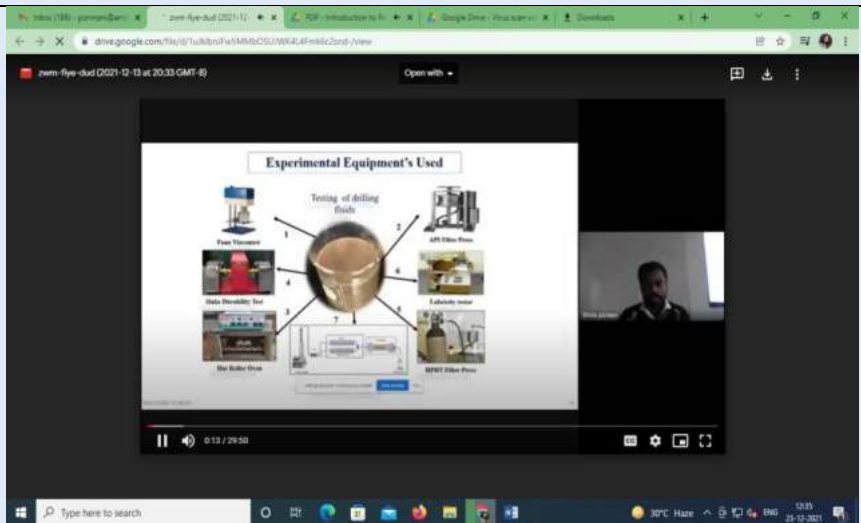

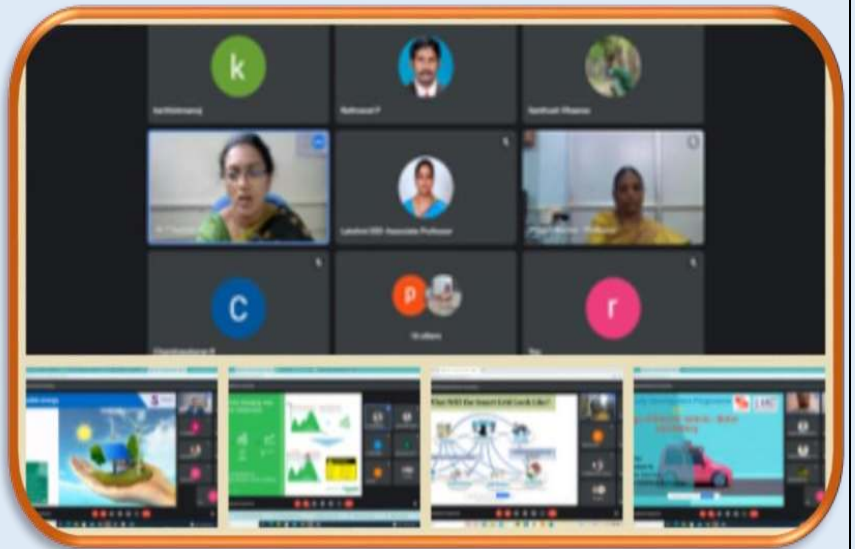


Department of NA & OE conducted an FDP on “Advances in strength of Materials and Manufacturing Engineering” from 6.10.2021 to 11.12.2021.
