1. Establishment of Research Centers and Centers of Excellence:

2. Promotion of Research Activities:

- Emphasis on various research activities, including:

 - Execution of Seed Money projects
 - Collaboration with industry for sponsored and consultancy projects
 - Pursuit of government-funded research initiatives.

3. Augmentation of Digital Resources:

- Implementation of strategies to enhance digital resources, fostering an improved teaching and learning process.
- Integration of advanced technological tools to facilitate innovative and effective methodologies in academic delivery.

4. Strengthening Startup Initiatives:

- Substantial increase in startup initiatives through the establishment and active operation of an Incubation Centre.
- Encouraging entrepreneurial spirit among students and faculty members, fostering a culture of innovation and enterprise.

5. Expansion of E-content Materials:

- Development of a comprehensive repository of E-content to supplement and enrich academic curricula.
