Good oral health is extremely important for general wellbeing of an individual. Some common oral health diseases are dental caries and periodontitis which effect 60 to 80 percent respectively, of the Indian population.




Figure 1.Pamplet Distribution on 5th and 6th April-AMET Team




Figure 2.Banner placed at the entrance of the School




Figure 3. People are waiting at corrider

Category: Extension Activity on Vedic Mathematics and Numerical Reasoning

About the Program:

Vedic Mathematics, or simply Vedic Maths, is a given name - for a system of Indian Mathematics discovered by Sri Bharati Krishna Tirthaji (1884-1960), as part of his research of scriptures (dating Vedic times) that contained 'GanitaSūtra', and were earlier rejected. According to his (years of) research, he deciphered these 'GanitaSūtra' and concluded that (practical) mathematics in ancient times was based on 16 Sūtras, or word-formulae.

His research is believed to be related with Atharvaveda - often called the 'Veda of magical formulas', and the Upaveda: Sthāpathyaveda - that comprises all kinds of architectural and structural human endeavours. It is obvious that the entire 'ancient traditions of mathematics' came to light because of his works, and all related works on Vedic Mathematics revolve around his initial works - 16 volumes, each on every Sūtra - which were irretrievably lost. He served the GovardhanPeeth, PuriJagannath - as JagadguruSankaracharya (1884-1960) - and propagated Vedism and Vedic Mathematics all over the world through innumerous lectures and demonstrations. It was only during his last days, and the enterprise of some disciples who took down notes, that the book of 'Vedic Mathematics' was published in 1965 - almost 5 years after his demise.




Figure 3. Our Research Scholar Mrs. R. Usha Rani explaining how to multiply the four digit numbers through Vedic Mathematics.




Figure 4.Students were interacting with full attention.


